



PURPOSE

The purpose of this program is to provide financial assistance to undergraduate students who are participating in low-paying or volunteer research or internships *that contribute to their educational goals and to the fields of agriculture and natural resources*. Funds may be used to help offset expenses including transportation, living expenses, tuition, and supplies only. Applications for International Internships will also be considered for additional support from the Global Experience Fund.

CRITERIA

1. Primary consideration is given to undergraduate students participating in volunteer or low-paying internships/research.
2. Preference will be given to CAS undergraduate students; however students in non-CAS undergraduate majors working in agriculture and natural resources internships/research with CAS faculty are eligible to apply.
3. Relationship of research/internship to the student's expressed educational goals.
4. Faculty recommendation.
5. Minimum overall cumulative grade point average of 2.75; preference to 3.0 and above.
6. Student's financial need.
7. Quality and content of student's essay.
8. Leadership potential and involvement as documented on a resume.

INSTRUCTIONS FOR COMPLETING APPLICATION FOR FUNDING

The application packet must include:

- A completed application form.
- A one-page essay explaining your educational goals; relationship of the research/internship to your educational goals; relationship of the internship to agriculture or natural resources; how this funding support will be used; describe the new experience and knowledge you hope to gain through this experience.
- A statement identifying proposed learning outcomes as discussed with an internship advisor.
- A letter from a faculty member supporting your request for funding.
- An unofficial transcript of all college-level coursework completed to date.
- A resume.

- October 15, 2021, for winter term consideration
- January 28, 2022, for spring term consideration
- April 22, 2022, for summer and fall term consideration

Exceptional applicants will be interviewed for further consideration. Funding decisions will be made following the interview process.
