Calendar of Activities and Significant Outcomes

September 20, 2018: Board Conference Call to prepare for October 19, 2018 Annual Meeting.

October 16, 2018: Board provided \$2500 in support of the College's Experiential Exposition.

October 19, 2018: Annual Meeting at the OSU Foundation; approximately 20 members attended in addition to the Board, members of College Administration, and 12 students who presented on activities supported by ER Jackman funds. February 25, 2019: Board Conference Call; Approved Budget for 2019-2020. Identified potential new Board members.

April 19, 2019: Board met with Dean Alan Sams to discuss his vision for the future activities for ER Jackman Friends and Alumni; Dean Sams reinforced the importance of the student support provided by the ER Jackman Funds and encouraged us to continue our work, including exploring additional ways to engage our Alumni and Friends. It was acknowledged that increasing our level of activity will be dependent on the appointment of a new external relations staff member to assist.

May 2, 2019: Dr. Dale Weber, assisted by Dr. Kelvin Koong, Board members Kim Bellingar and Karen Withers, held the Internship Interviews for Summer/Fall. Twelve students received \$14,200 in awards ranging from \$500 to \$2,000 each. Four of these students received additional funding from the Global Experience Fund to support their international travel.

May 23, 2019: Denver Pugh, Board President, Stella Coakley and Dr. Lynda Ciuffetti did interviews for Club Funding, including Ambassadors and Agricultural Executive Council. Approximately \$ 40 K was awarded to twenty different groups for 2019-2020.

June 17, 2019: Board Conference Call; new Board Members confirmed: John McCulley, John Roberts, and Kathy Ward for three year terms.

June 30, 2019: Value of ER Jackman Endowment Funds was \$ 2,413,818 with Total Holdings of \$ 2,587,573. Roughly \$ 112,000 of our income was directed to support of students: Beginning Researcher Program: \$ 14,250 for 16 students with faculty across 8 departments. Scholarships: \$20,000 to 10 students across 7 majors. Internship/Research Financial Support: \$ 19,200 to 18 students across 6 majors. Club Funding: \$ 42,000 for 21 clubs. LSAMP: \$ 16,350. CAS Experiential Expo: \$2500.
