<i>Chaenactis douglasii</i>	Douglas' dustymaiden	May to July
<b><i>Cleome serrulata</i></b>	<b>Rocky mountain beeplant</b>	June to August
<b><i>Monardella odoratissima</i></b>	<b>Monardella</b>	July to August
<b><i>Machaeranthera canescens</i></b>	<b>Hoary tansyaster</b>	Mid-Aug to L. Sept.
<b><i>Ericameria nauseosa</i></b>	<b>Gray rabbitbrush</b>	August to Sept.
<b><i>Chrysothamnus viscidiflorus</i></b>	<b>Green rabbitbrush</b>	August to Sept.
