
Nightshades, Solanum ssp.



Habitat: Roadsides, fencerows, ditches, cultivated fields

and hedgerows

Animals Affected: Livestock and humans

Toxin Family: Steroidal glycoalkaloids

Other: Decreased heart and respiratory rates, muscle weakness, colic; can lead to cardiac arrest. Rarely eaten unless no other forage is present. Bright berries of *S*.

dulcamara can be attractive to children.
